
PHONICS 2 (FIRST FRIENDS 2) 1 ST SEMESTER Teacher: Ms. Ghazi

Spelling part:

We:

- learned about writing and reading numbers from 1-20
- reviewed the alphabet letters and also practiced the example words of each letter.
- started to learn how to blend the vowel sounds and consonants to read, write & make simple words, such as: "hat, bat, cat, set, met, pet, It, sit, pit, cut ,...."
- ▶ learned how to read and write Tricky words like: "I, you, is, are, has,...."
- also learned about long sounds : ch, th, sh
- ▶ could read, write & make sentences easily, after all.

-Dictation practice helped the students apply phonics skills to their writing. We have got a weekly dictation routine in the classroom!





-Phonics involves matching the sounds of spoken English with individual letters or groups of letters.







Conversation & words:

We:

- learned many words about school things, toys, animals, beach, foods
- learned the shapes: Triangle, square, rectangle, circle
- learned how to talk about our feelings such as: scared, happy, sad, cold, hot ,...
